
Sundon Park Junior School Weekly Newsletter

English Next Week

Year 3

In English next week, Year 3 will be learning a Roman myth about how Rome began. They will look in particular at the main characters and what they are like.

Year 4

Next week in English, Year 4 will be learning a wishing tale linked to our topic on Ancient Greece. We will be focussing on characterisation, appearance, what the character says and what the character does. We will explore the tale further through drama.

Year 5

In English, we will be learning about the story of Charlie and the Golden Ticket and looking at how the story is structured/written. We will then attempt to write our own.

Year 6

Next week, Year 6 will be busy revising for the upcoming SATs. We will be looking at answering questions relating to texts that require us to make a point, find evidence and give an explanation for our choice. In our writing, we will be learning to use both the active and passive voice.

Maths Next Week

Year 3

In maths next week, Year 3 are continuing to learn about time. This includes key time facts such as how many minutes in an hour, hours in a day etc. The children will also be learning ways to identify how long events take and comparing time durations.

Year 4

Next week in maths, Year 4 will be using a formal method to solve multiplication and complete correspondence problems.

Year 5

In maths next week, we are consolidating our knowledge of negative numbers, interpreting them in context and using our reasoning and problem solving skills.

Year 6

Year 6 will be practising calculations using formal methods. We will be using our reasoning skills to explain our answers to mathematical problems.
