Welcome

All student school council representatives were welcomed to the meeting and thanked for their attendance and hard work towards supporting the School Council.

Sport for Champions

As announced in assembly last week, this fund raising event will take place on Wednesday 26th April. Leon Baptiste, 100m Sprinter, will come to the school to run the event. Ms Goultier will support the event also, collecting the classes to come and take part.

On the day, all of the children should come to school in their indoor sports kit (correct kit should be worn). The children should bring something warm to wear at break/lunch time.

All children in F2 – Y6 will take part in a carousel of activities during the morning to raise money for the Sport for Champions. The school will receive 60% of the money raised to spend on school development.

The school council were asked to discuss with their class what they feel that the money should be spent on. This should be something that we are in need of. Ideas should be written in the school council note book and brought to the next school council meeting.

School Values

Mrs Levers conducted a survey during the meeting regarding how many School Council Representatives could name all 10 of the School Values. None of the School Council Representatives could name them all, and collectively they could only name 6. In addition none of the School Council Representatives could tell Mrs Levers where the School Value display was located.

The School Council representatives were asked how the school could promote the values further so that all children could name and explain the Values. The initial ideas were

- Children doing fun things to show the values
- Children are given 'hearts' to show that they have displayed one of the Values. Children can earn extra rewards for receiving 'hearts'
- Playground games focussing on the hearts
- Painting a school mural based on the Values
- Improving the whole school display.

Mrs Levers explained that kindness assembly has originally been changed to 'Values' assembly, and that kindness boxes had been changed to 'Values' boxes at the start of this academic year. However since then 'value assembly' had been replaced with 'Express' assembly. This would be reconsidered for the start of the next academic year.

Mrs Levers asked the School Council Representatives to survey their class with regards to idea on how the values could be promoted. In addition, Mrs Levers would like to create a school poem or song based on the Values, and for the School Council to take part in this. Ideas should be notes in their School council notebook and brought to the next meeting.
