In support of 'National Women in Engineering Day' Yorkshire Water will be hosting activity sessions at their Education Centre at Headingley Water Treatment Works on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2017. It is an educational half a day visit which links Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM). The aim of the visit is further enrich your child's experience of these subject areas beyond the school environment and help to put them into 'real life' context, as the visit will focus on STEM career opportunities.

Yorkshire Water has an aspiration to reverse the trend of a national shortage of skilled engineers within the UK, particularly within the water industry. They wish to engage young people, especially girls, in the wide variety of possible careers available to children who study STEM subjects.

We are very pleased to have the opportunity to give pupils this 'hands-on' experience. The activities Yorkshire Water provide are free of charge, however the cost of the coaches is £400 (this works out at £6.25 per pupil). In line with our voluntary contributions policy, we would like to ask parents/carers to make a voluntary contribution of **£6.25 per pupil**. Payment can be made through the ParentPay system. In the event of insufficient funds being collected the visits may be cancelled and all monies returned.

The girls will need to wear school uniform for the visit and bring a packed lunch and a waterproof coat.
