## English Next Week

### Year 3

In English next week, Year 3 will be learning all of the features of an information text and will practise these through shared writing on a new Roman topic.

### Year 4

Next week in English, we will be learning an explanation text linked to our science work this term.

### Year 5

Next week, Year 5 will be working on their non-fiction writing. We will also be learning an information text about Mr Willy Wonka's Chocolate Factory.

### Year 6

Year 6 will be learning a story based on Kensuke's Kingdom written by Michael Morpurgo. We will be learning to write diary entries that have a sense of anticipation and adventure.

## Maths Next Week

### Year 3

In maths next week year 3 are going to be exploring fractions. We will learn how to represent fractions pictorially and how to compare and order them.

### Year 4

Next week in maths, we will be learning to convert between different units of measure. For example, km into m and hours into minutes. We will also learn to estimate, compare and calculate in different measures, including money in pounds and pence.

### Year 5

In maths next week, we will be exploring different timetables, reading them and creating our own. We will be using our reasoning skills to help us answer questions about them.

### Year 6

Year 6 will be using their reasoning skills to learn to master place value.
