Impact: *Communication & Language* - 30 children were at age related expectation so did not take part in Wellcomm. 26/56 across the setting took part in Wellcomm and of the 26, 23 made at least expected progress in developing language skills.
19 children made accelerated progress in developing language skills.
Personal, Social & Emotional: Baseline data suggested that 17.5% of children were at age related expectation
