English Next Week

Year 3

In English next week, Year 3 will be using all their newly acquired skills to research, plan and write an information text about an aspect of the Roman Empire.

Year 4

Next week in English, Year 4 will be writing their own explanation texts about how animals are adapted to their environment. We will then also use our explanation skills in science.

Year 5

Next week in Year 5, we will be writing our own reports. We will choose a character for Charlie and the Chocolate factory and brainstorm ideas, and then plan and write an information text about that character.

Year 6

Year 6 will be learning to write a discussion text. We will plan a balanced argument and use a wide range of sentence structures and punctuation.

Maths Next Week

Year 3

In maths next week, Year 3 will be continuing to learn about fractions. Children will learn how to represent fractions pictorially. They will also learn how to add and subtract fractions and solve problems relating to fractions.

Year 4

Next week in Year 4 we will be estimating and comparing using different measures, including money in pounds and pence. We will also be solving problems involving different measures.

Year 5

In maths next week we are solving problems involving time. These will include seconds, minutes, hours, days, weeks, months and years.

Year 6

Year 6 will be applying their knowledge to solve problems and explain their reasoning by converting measurements of length, mass, volume and time from a smaller unit of measure to a larger unit, and vice versa, using decimal notation of up to three decimal places.
