

Welcome to the summer term. We are hoping for some good weather to enable us to get outside and do some gardening and learning outdoors!



Literacy

We will be reading a range of fiction texts and looking at a range of information texts linked to our topics. We will continue to encourage the children to write independently making accurate use of the following punctuation marks:

Full stops, Question marks, Exclamation marks, Speech marks and Commas in lists.

Please continue to hear your child read every day and ask plenty of open ended questions to aid your child's comprehension. Please write in the Reading Record book when you hear your child read and discuss the text.



Maths

The children will continue adding 2 and 3 digit numbers and use subtraction as the inverse of addition. They will practise recalling number bonds to 10, 20 and 100 and will round numbers to the nearest 10. The children will continue to work on their 2, 5 and 10 times tables and begin to work on their 3 and 4 times table as appropriate. They will continue work on division as the inverse of multiplication and will complete problem solving activities involving money, measuring, 2D and 3D shapes and telling the time.

Science: Plants and Living things and their habitats



The children will learn about plants and animals around us and will be planting seeds and devising experiments which help them understand what helps plants to grow well. They will be looking at animals and where they live. We will be visiting Salcey Forest as part of our science work.

Geography: Flight

We will be using simple field work and observational skills to study the geography of our school and its surrounding environment. This will include looking at aerial photographs taken from hot air balloons, aeroplanes and helicopters.



History: Flight

The children will be learning about the Wright Brothers and Sir Frank Whittle. This will include the history of flight and different air crafts.



Computing:

The children will use the internet to research information for their topics. They will learn about emailing and collecting and presenting data.


RE: Questions about God

Design and Technology: Structures

The children will be looking at structures and using a variety of materials and construction kits to make things that fly!



Art: Printing

The children will create printing tiles and create a repeating pattern using a printing tile.



Music: Exploring Pitch & Instruments and Symbols

The children will learn to control the pitch of their voices and instruments by moving higher and lower.
