

Pupil premium report spring 2017

The following is a breakdown of progress across years 1-6 using the information uploaded onto target tracker by the teaching staff. Pupil Premium funding is used by the school to reduce the gap between those eligible children and their non-pupil premium peers. The funding pays for some additional staffing across the school and interventions are planned for the identified children in addition to the regular curriculum delivered by support staff and teachers throughout the school.
