Traffic light system – individuals

Each class room to display a 'traffic light' clearly with the following colours.

Sparkly	doing something exceptional – note/postcard sent home to parents
Green	All children to start here each morning and afternoon
Amber	Visual warning/ thinking time
Red	consequence (lose 5 minutes) time out slip sent home to parents

Children can move up and down the traffic light however once they get to red they cannot move and will receive a consequence. This will be a 5 minute timeout during playtime (in EYFS this will be an instant timeout for 5 minutes). The behaviour should be logged on SIMS by the adult involved and a timeout slip needs to be sent home to parents. Children missing playtime will go to a central place (year 2 classroom) and this will be monitored by a member of staff (on a timetabled rota).

Clear (yet not exhaustive) guidelines to be generated and followed to ensure that there is consistency in what warrants being moved from one colour to the next.

Playtime and Lunchtime

At playtimes and lunchtimes there will be a reflection bench for children to receive a timeout – this will replace the previously used 'hand hold'. A record of children being sent to the reflection bench needs to be kept and logged onto SIMS.

Reward – whole class

Marble jar – the class receive a marble in their jar for working well together or achieving something together. When the jar is full, the class will receive a reward that has been decided upon in advance. E.g. extra time playing in the court, art afternoon, cooking or a film. It is anticipated that this will happen no more than once a term.

Reward – individual/ teams

Children to individually have a sticker chart and to earn stickers for good behaviour, producing a good piece of work, demonstrating a school value etc.

Each child is assigned to a colour team. Once a child has filled their chart (10 stickers) it will be collected in a central place for their team. This can be counted and shared regularly with the children during assembly. Each half term the winning team will celebrate by having an extra playtime.

Celebration certificates

Pupil of the week and 2 achievement award certificates will be awarded per class during achievement assembly. Lunchtime awards to also be awarded. Shared in the newsletter on a Friday.
