Below are the winners of the sprints held at our sports afternoon before half term. Congratulations to them all. There's definitely some real talent in this all-star line-up.




### Volunteering at Luton and Dunstable Hospital

## English Next Week

### Year 3

In English next week, Year 3 will be looking more at the story 'The Alien Encounter' and learning what features can create suspense for the audience.

### Year 4

In English next week, Year 4 will be starting to write their own myths, with a focus on creating action and suspense.

### Year 5

Year 5 next week are continuing to learn the story 'The Door' and exploring aspects of characterisation. We will also look at the structure of defeating the monster stories.

### Year 6

Year 6 will be writing both a short story, using dialogue for effect, and an information text this week. They will be using their knowledge of using punctuation effectively to enhance their writing. They will learn to shift between levels of formality through selecting vocabulary precisely and by manipulating grammatical structures.

## Maths Next Week

### Year 3

In maths next week, Year 3 are going to be exploring 3D shapes through a DT project. We will examine images of Roman buildings to identify the 2D and 3D shapes and what they are made up of. We will then use this information to construct our own 3D models.

### Year 4

We will be learning to read, write and convert time between analogue and digital 12- and 24-hour clocks. We will then progress onto solving problems involving time.

### Year 5

Next week in Maths, Year 5 will be learning about volume and capacity where they will practise estimating and solving problems.

### Year 6

Year 6 will be using their mathematical skills within investigations in Science.
