

### English (Article 29)

**Reading:** Our class author is Mairi Hedderwick.

**RWI:** 3 days a week for 1 hour.

**English:** English lessons this term will be focussed heavily upon writing skills. Our writing will be topic based and will be related to seaside holidays where possible. The genres we will be covering are recounts, story writing and retells.

**SPaG:** RWI scheme and specific lessons taught on a weekly basis.

### Music/P.E

This term in P.E we will be focussing on athletics in preparation for sports day. The children will partake in many games and activities all aimed at boosting their fitness levels.

Music will take the form of singing lessons and we will be following the Year 2 Music Express scheme.

### Maths (Article 29)

The pupil can subtract mentally a two-digit number from another two-digit number when there is no re-grouping required (e.g.  $74 - 33$ ).

The pupil can recognise the inverse relationships between addition and subtraction and use this to check calculations and work out missing number problems (e.g.  $\Delta - 14 = 28$ ).

The pupil can identify 13, 14, 12, 24, 34 and knows that all parts must be equal parts of the whole.

### Computing

This term during computing lessons we will be accessing Lexia which is an online resource aimed at improving reading and comprehension skills.

## Summer Term

### Art/D.T

Both Art and D.T will be cross curricular and be focussed upon the seaside holiday topic. -We will be going on a class trip to Seaton, where we will be making sand castles/sculptures on the beach. We will also be making some sand art pictures in class.

### Topic (Article 27)

#### **Seaside Holidays from past to present**

To identify features of a seaside holiday.

To find out about what seaside holidays were like in the past.

To find out when and how seaside holidays became popular.

To find out what seaside holidays were like 100 years ago.

To be able to identify similarities and differences between seaside holidays now and in the past.

**WOW Factor** - Children will be going to Seaton beach to build sandcastles and to look at the key geographical features.

### Science

This term our science topic will be plants and habitats. We will look at what plants need to grow and we will be planting plants in class. For habitats we will be building our own mini beast hotel and exploring our local area searching for wildlife.

### PSHE/R.E (Links to Article 12&13)

-**PSHE:** We will be following the SEAL programme– Relationships and Changes.

-In **R.E** our first topic title is **Pentecost 'Serving'**. Children will be able to **talk** about their own experience and feelings of both passing and receiving messages.

Our second R.E topic title is **'Islam'**. Our focus during this topic will be upon how Muslims pray.

-Our third topic of the term is **Reconciliation**. During this topic children will be able to **recognise** some religious words and signs that Christians use to express sorrow and forgiveness.
