Please can I remind parents that if you have a child who may be entitled to the **additional 15 hours of Nursery provision** following their third birthday, the application for this needs to be made during the term before that in which they are 3. If you forget to apply, you will have to wait until the following term to claim your place. Once you have generated your eligibility code this needs to be given to Mrs Bryden who will then verify this code and inform you it is valid and that you have a secure 30 hours place, whether you use all 30 hours or otherwise.
