## English Next Week

### Year 3

In English next week, Year 3 will be learning to create suspense using the toolkit they picked out this week through shared writing.

### Year 4

Next week, Year 4 will be using all the techniques and vocabulary they have gathered so far to plan and write their own myth.

## Maths Next Week

### Year 3

### Year 4

In Year 4 next week, we will be solving time problems. This will include word problems, as well as problems relating to timetables and calendars.

### Year 5

Next week, Year 5 will be solving problems that involve knowing decimal, fraction and percentage equivalents.

### Year 6

Year 6 will be using problem solving and thinking skills to solve mathematical problems. They will continue to use their mathematical skills in their science lessons.
