Boys Cricket Tournament – 23rd May

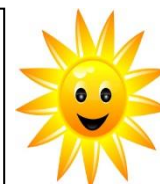
The Foxdell Boys Cricket Team did a great job by coming 3rd place in the tournament which was held at The Luton Town & Indians Cricket Club.
