English Next Week

Year 3

In English next week, Year 3 will be learning an explanation text about how aliens communicate. They will learn the features, structure and vocabulary that go into writing one.

Year 4

Next week Year 4 will be writing their own inventions using all we have learnt in our fiction unit focusing on creating action and suspense. We will publish our work in a class book so that everyone can enjoy reading it.

Year 5

Next week, Year 5 will be writing their own conquering fear tale focusing on how to create characterisation in their stories. This will include using figurative language, expanded noun phrases and much more.

Year six will be learning to write letters this week. These will show a shift in formality and use both active and passive voice.

Maths Next Week

Year 3

Next week in maths, we are continuing our work with money. We will also be revisiting multiplication and division.

Year 4

Next week in Year 4, we will be using a variety of different problem solving methods to solve a variety of mathematical problems.

Year 5

Next week in maths, Year 5 are solving number problems within the context of decimals, up to 3 decimal places.

Year 6

Year 6 will be using problem solving and thinking skills to solve mathematical problems. They will continue to use their mathematical skills in their science lessons.
