Our year five and six children visited Borwick Hall for a three day residential visit. They were able to take part in a range of activities and opportunities which they thoroughly enjoyed.

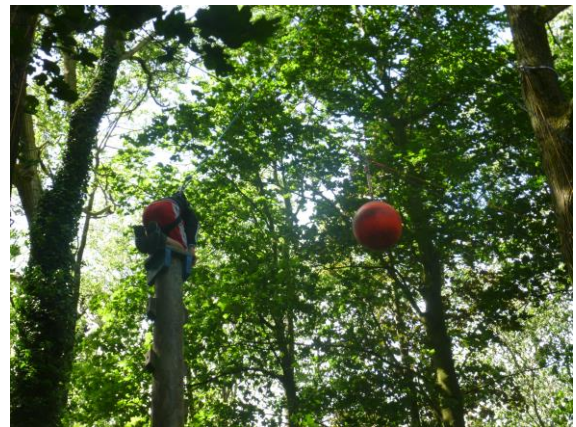


One of the activities was abseiling which was a new experience for the children.
