Please can the parents of children taking part in the **London Residential** be aware of the following cancellation charges for the visit which would be payable by you should you cancel your child's place.  
56-29 days before the visit - Loss of 30% of total tour price  
28-15 days before the visit - Loss of 45%  
14-02 days - Loss of 60%  
01 day or on or after the visit start - Loss of 100%  
It would also be payable if school cancelled the visit on advice from our Health & Safety provider.
