As we have had rising costs in wages and running expenses during the last 5 years it has been decided at the recent AGM of the OOSC that costs will increase to the following in September:

7.50-8.50am will be £3.75/session, rising 25p
3.15-4.30pm will be £3.75/session, rising 25p
3.15-5.30pm will be £7.50/session, rising 50p
Both evening sessions will continue to include a snack. As you can see, we have tried to keep the increase to a minimum. Thank you for your support.
