First Week back is Week 1 of the new menu available on our website

Please note the cost a school dinner will increase to **£2.30** with effect from 5th September 2017.

Please remember to send in your child's snack order for the whole term on Tuesday 5th September

Please check your Parent Pay account is in credit by **9.00am on a Monday morning** for dinners and morning snack each week. Please clear any outstanding balances on ParentPay by 1st September or your child will be unable to receive a school meal.

For pupils moving from Year 2 to Year 3 school meals will now need to be paid for.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

If you are in receipt of benefits such as Income Support, Income Based Job Seekers Allowance, Support Allowance, Universal Credit or Child Tax Credit (but are not entitled to a Working Tax Credit) and whose annual income (as assessed by HMRC) does not exceed £16,190, then your child may well be entitled to free school meals.

Please register even if your child is in Reception, Y1 or Y2 and entitled to the KS1 Free Meal.
