Busking will commence at 10.45am on the junior playground. Performances will go on until lunch time, approximately 12:15pm. If it is a dry day then we shall be picnicking on the field. Parents are welcome to bring a blanket and picnic lunch to eat with their child/children. If wet, busking will take place inside the school and we will say cheerio to families at the end of the performances. A programme of events will be sent home next week.
