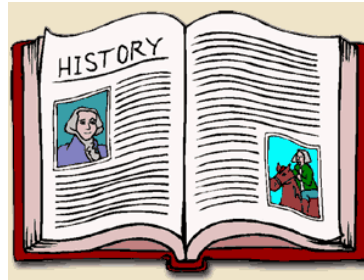


Somerville Primary School
