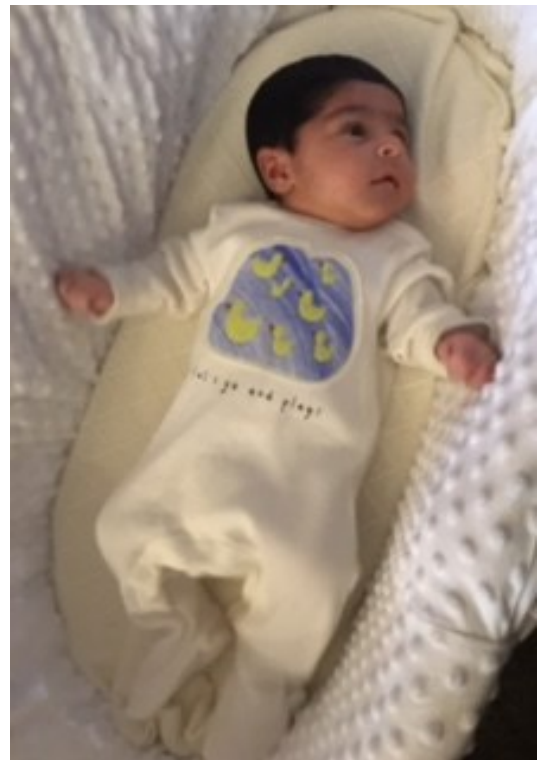


Hello
