Topics, educational visits and curriculum coverage this term

Our topic titles this term are...Marvellous Me and Toy Story

English - We will be reading lots of traditional tales. We will be practising our letter formation and we will be writing sentences about the stories. We will also be looking at recipes and writing letters linked to the Jolly Christmas Postman.

Maths - We will be teaching the children how to independently access Maths Passport. Children will also become very confident using, ordering and making numbers to 10 and learning their number bonds to the same number. We will be problem solving and getting used to explaining how we have worked problems out.

Topic, ICT and Art/DT - Children will learn how to access the provision areas this term to aid their independent learning. They will explore their own personal timelines, make a puppet or moving toy and create autumnal artwork based on the trees in the school and its surroundings. In Computing, children will learn how to log on to a computer using a password and access a program

Science - We will be learning about our bodies and senses and exploring the uses and properties of everyday materials

P.E- We will be developing our sportsmanship and teamwork through learning rules and playing different games. We will develop different ways of travelling through balancing, rolling, and jumping in gymnastics.
