

English

Zero Tolerance Skills – the pupils will recap and consolidate their knowledge of the zero tolerance skills, which are: capital letters, full stops, correct letter formation and beginning to join their handwriting.

Book Study: The Story of Ferdinand

During the book study the pupils will: recall the story using Talk4Writing techniques; complete character descriptions; write an alternative ending and write a persuasive argument about bull-fighting.

Computing

The pupils will begin to familiarise themselves with Scratch software and learn basic coding. This will involve basic algorithms, knowing angles, position and direction.

History/Geography Spain

The pupils will learn:

- To locate Spain on a map of the world using atlases and globes.
- To locate Spain in a map of Europe and understand that Spain is part of a group of countries part of the European Union.
- To compare and contrast the human and physical features of the UK and Spain.
- To identify Spanish traditions and understand how they have developed over time.

PE & Games

The unit that the pupils will focus on this half term is gymnastics. They will learn how to sequence various positions, transitions and techniques into a gymnastic performance by the end of the half term.

Maths

Number and Place Value

- Find 10 and 100 more and less than any given number up to 1000.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number.
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000.
- Count from 0 in multiples of 50 and 100.

Addition and Subtraction

- Add and subtract a number mentally; including a three-digit number and ones, a three-digit number and tens and a three-digit number and hundreds.
- Add and subtract numbers up to three-digits using the formal column method.

RE & PSHE

Drugs, alcohol and tobacco

Pupils will learn:

- What a drug is and that drugs can be harmful or helpful.
- The effects and dangers of smoking and second-hand smoke.
- The help and support available for someone to stop smoking or to become smoke-free.

Science

Animals including humans

The pupils will learn:

- Types of nutrition
- Amount of nutrition needed for humans and other animals
- Types of skeleton
- Names of bones
- Functions of a skeleton
- Muscles and movement

Art & Design

Pupils will learn about famous Spanish artists: Pablo Picasso, Antoni Gaudi and Salvador Dali and then complete art work in the same styles.
