




Dear Parents, Carers and Friends,

Harvest Festival Service Arrangements – Friday 6th October, 2.00pm

A reminder to everyone that our Harvest Festival Service will take place on Friday, 6th October, at All Saints' Church, Kilham, starting at 2.00pm.

As usual, we are supporting two causes, a local cause and a global cause. Our local cause is The Driffield Food Bank—more information at <http://together.ourchurchweb.org.uk/driffield/features/foodbank/>.



We would therefore welcome any non-perishable food items, such as Milk (UHT or powdered), Sugar, Soups, Pasta sauces, tinned puddings, tomatoes, cereals, rice pudding, tea Bags/instant coffee, instant mash potato, rice/pasta, tinned meat/fish, etc. Please let the children bring these into school and we will make a display in the main corridor. The Driffield Food Bank is run by 'Churches Together' at All Saints Parish Hall and they are always grateful for our contributions for those in our area who find themselves in hardship or in need.

In the last couple of years we have supported Christian Aid in several different ways and also supported the Mbedza Projects Support charity, most notable with their stoves appeal. As both of these appeals support projects in Malawi, we will be splitting any financial donations between these appeals. We will be having special assemblies in school to teach the children about the plight of the harvest in Malawi and how they are planting a special crop of 'pigeon peas'.

On the day of the Harvest Service, all the children from Reception and classes 2, 3, 4 and 5 will be going down to Church – as usual, everyone will come back to school afterwards but children can then be collected and taken home. Nursery children will be staying at school.

Lunchtime Clubs

'Games Clubs' for years 3 to 6, take place on Tuesday and Wednesday lunchtimes. Please have PE kit in school (and outdoor trainers) if your child would like to take part. The clubs will focus on different games each half-term. This half-term, it will be Rugby on Tuesdays and Hockey on Wednesdays.

Multi-Skills Club will now take place each Thursday lunchtime, weather permitting. This club is run by Goal Sports and is funded by the Government's 'Sport Premium' funding. All children from Reception to Year 6 will be able to access the club during lunchtime. Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 will have the first half-hour, before going in for lunch (packed lunch required), and Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 can go and take part as from 12.30, after 'first sitting'. PE kit will be required.

RM EasiMaths Club

Invite letters to our early morning RM EasiMaths Club, run by Mrs Burnett, should now have been sent home. Please do take up this opportunity of extra support if it is offered – the RM EasiMaths system really does help the children make progress in maths, especially if they can fit in 3 sessions a week!
