After School Care

Our After School Care is available from 3pm until either 4.30pm or extended to 5pm. All care must be booked on a Monday and paid for in advance.

The staff who run the after school care are only paid until 5pm but regularly end up staying late because children are late being picked up. A member of the leadership team also stays until the last child has been collected. This is usually me and on occasions, late collection of children has meant that my own children have been late for an after school activity that I take them to. This is unacceptable. Children **must** be collected **before 5pm** not 5 or 10 minutes after 5 and certainly not at 5.30pm.

Similarly if you child is only booked in until 4.30pm they **must** be collected **before 4.30pm** as we reduce our staffing at this point.

We extended our after school care following requests from parents so would ask that you respect these times. If you cannot be here before 5pm then you will have to find alternative care for your child. We reserve the right to refuse any children in the future who are collected late and if this situation does not improve we will withdraw our after school care.
