

Autumn Term in Year 6



LESSONS IN YEAR SIX

In year 6 your child will be taught in a group for Maths. For all the other core and non-core subjects they will be taught as a whole class.

HOME-SCHOOL CONTACT BOOK

This year your child will be given a Home-School Contact Book. This book is a really important link between home and school. In the book will be your child's weekly spellings, weekly homework and their home reader log. Please look at this book regularly. It is really important that your child has their book in school everyday.

IMPORTANCE OF HOMEWORK

Each week your child will be given three pieces of homework (Maths, GPS and Comprehension). It is very important that all homework is completed because it reinforces work that has been done in the classroom. Homework will be given out on **FRIDAY** and must be back in school by the following **FRIDAY**. If homework is not completed, children will be expected to do the homework during their lunch time. If a pupil repeatedly fails to complete their homework, parents will be informed.

READING IN YEAR SIX

In year 6 the emphasis is placed on independent reading. When your child has read at home please could you sign and date their home-school contact book. Your child's reading will be assessed at regular intervals in school. Parents will be informed if the teacher has any concerns.

P.E

Children need both indoor and outdoor kits in school.

BEHAVIOUR IN YEAR SIX

All pupils are expected to follow the school's behaviour policy. Class teachers will put sanctions into place for poor/ inappropriate behaviour. The class teacher and Mrs. Whittaker will deal with serious incidents. Parents will be informed immediately so that they can support school and the problems can be dealt with swiftly.

Y6 SATs

Key Stage Two SATs are Standardised Assessment Tests, which assess pupils' academic ability at the end of their primary school years. Next year, if your child is in Y6, they will be doing their SATs during the week beginning **Monday 14th May 2018**. The SATs are a very important part of your child's education, it is vital that pupils' attendance and punctuality is 100%.
