This week, you need to **choose one task, from the menu, that you want to do**. You can choose either a bronze, silver or gold activity. It is totally up to you, which one you choose, as long as you are challenging yourself. **If you want to you may do more than one activity.**

You only need to do one of the following, so which one will you choose?

Menu

Bronze: For everyone to try.

Silver: If you're feeling confident.

Gold: An extra challenge.

Bronze:

This week, as it was his birthday, we have celebrated Roald Dahl day. For your homework, you have been given a comprehension to match to your reading level. Your task is to answer the questions given, by writing the answers in your book. Remember to answer in full punctuated sentences.

e.g

What did Roald Dahl think about school?

Roald Dahl hated going to school, because he didn't like the teacher.

Silver: To complete the comprehension as in bronze. Then for an extra task to pick 5 different sentences from the text. Then add a noun phrase to the sentence.

Remember a noun phrase is more than one adjective and a noun.

For example:

He crashed his plane into the desert. = He crashed his **expensive, war plane** into the **hot, deserted African dessert.**

Gold: To complete the comprehension as in bronze. Then for an extra task to pick 5 different sentences from the text. Then add a relative clause to the sentence.

Remember a relative clause adds extra information and has commas around it and often starts with who, which, what and that

For example:

He crashed his plane into the African desert. = He crashed his plane, **which was a fighter plane**, into the African desert
