We aim to engage all pupils in regular physical activity and allow staff the opportunity to improve their teaching, understanding and confidence of delivery of the P.E. Curriculum. We also plan to increase the amount of competitive participation in sport throughout a range of activities and events.

Objectives of Spending PPSG:

- Broaden the sporting opportunities and experiences available to pupils.
- To ensure that children are receiving at least two hours of quality P.E. Provision per week.
- Increase engagement and motivation to develop a love of sport and physical activity.
- To raise the profile of PE and Sport across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
