

Step 5 : If you get this far you can choose one of the Golden envelopes – these contain prizes including an invitation to Afternoon Tea with the Headteacher!

Step 4 : A Good news postcard will be sent home through the post telling your family how proud we are of you.

Step 3 : You've made your way up the ladder again! You will be given the opportunity to talk about your good behaviour with the Headteacher or the Assistant Headteachers.

Step 2 : You have earned some Golden Time!

Step 1 : Your name is put on a rung, and you get a sticker / stamp.

  **A Good Starting Place !**  

Step 1 : An initial verbal warning - You are asked to think about making the right choices and changing your behaviour.

Step 2 : If your behaviour continues to be challenging you will be sent to work on your own within your Classroom. You will lose your break time / **stand against the wall.**

Step 3 : If you continue to behave inappropriately, you will be sent to work in another Classroom / **sit on the Time Out Bench, and your teacher will be informed.**

Step 4 : If you receive 2 or more instances of being sent to another class in a week, you will go to see the Headteacher / Assistant Headteacher, and a letter will be sent home. Parents will be asked to come in for a meeting. This makes sure that we are working with your parents to help support your behaviour.

Step 5 : If you get this far down the ladder, you will spend the next day working in seclusion, with break time and lunch time taken separately to the other children. Your parents / carers will be informed.
