At Broadhurst we try to make the learning as fun and interactive as possible. We invite visitors in to school and take the children out on Educational Visits to enhance the learning experience for our pupils. Unfortunately this is becoming increasingly difficult as the government make more and more cuts to our funding.

Usually our Educational Visits are heavily subsidised and we try to keep the cost to you at a minimum. From now on we will not be able to subsidise visits to the same extent so the cost will rise. We are still trying to budget for some of the cost but not as much as we have in the past.

We are looking at making sure there is only one visit in each year group as far as we can. I appreciate the financial demands on families but without a contribution from all parents or carers we will not be able to run the visits.

Similarly when we have an event in school, like a workshop or visitor we have to pay for, we may need to charge a small amount towards the overall cost.

I am sorry that this is the case and it saddens me that we are not able to provide these experiences free of charge but unfortunately this is the reality in most schools now.
