History:

Guy Fawkes and Bonfire Night.
The Great Fire of London: Where and when the fire happened, why it spread so quickly, eye witness accounts (Samuel Pepys diary)

ICT:

Learning how to store, retrieve and edit files.
Creating a labelled picture of an animal.
Digital Research: find out about The Great Fire of London.
Using the zoom facility on digital maps.

Science:

Animals - identifying and naming common animals, describe how animals look the same and different to one another, grouping animals, animal senses. Animals that live in hot and cold places.
The Seasons and seasonal change: observe changes across the four seasons throughout the year.

PE:

Games: Aiming at targets when throwing and kicking objects; introducing tactics and defence strategies.
Gymnastics: Develop balance, travelling, rolling and jumping skills to link together in a sequence.

English

Stories by the same author, poems on a theme, a range of non-fiction texts and non-chronological reports.

Phonics; continuing to blend and segment words for reading and writing, learning alternative spelling of sounds (e.g. ai/ay/a-e, igh/ie/i-e, ow/ou.) Spelling high frequency words and using knowledge of phonics to choose correct sound for spelling words. Rules for plurals e.g. adding s or es. Developing the correct grammar and sentence structure, writing in sentences; nouns, adjectives and verbs.

Recognising and using capital letters and full stops consistently.

Handwriting, forming **all** letters correctly, lower case and capital letters, writing ascenders (b, d, h, k, l,) and descenders (g, j, p, q, y) correctly.

Maths

Counting forwards and backwards, comparing and ordering numbers, using the greater than and less than symbols (< >), place value and partitioning numbers, knowing the value of a digit in a 2 and 3 digit number, finding 1 more/1 less, 10 more/10 less than a given number, rounding numbers to the nearest 10. Writing numbers using the correct formation.

Addition and subtraction facts to 20, adding and subtracting a single digit to and from any two-digit number, doubling and halving, recognising multiples of 2, 5 and 10. Fractions - halves and quarters. Length, mass/weight.

2D and 3D shape: know names of shapes and describe their properties, sorting 2D and 3D shapes.

Money: know the value of different denominations of coins, solve problems.

Time: days of the week, months of the year, telling the time to the quarter hour.
