



PE Sports Premium Strategy 2017-2018

During the academic year 2017-18, the government have allocated £18,770 to the school. Funding must be used to make additional and sustained improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer.

Our strategy for 2017-18 focuses on achieving the following outcomes:

- New and further opportunities for pupils to be active provided
- Increased participation in sports and active clubs
- Further improved staff skills in delivering curriculum PE
- Successful partnership working with cluster schools in the TASA (TARDiS Active School's Alliance) has removed barriers for pupils to represent the school in competitions and a higher proportion of pupils has represented the school
- Opportunities for targeted pupils has ensured they have developed key skills and have narrowed the gap on other pupils
- Achieve the Gold School Games Mark for the second year

How and when will this be monitored?

The strategy will be monitored by the PE Subject Leader and the Headteacher through observation, pupil attitudinal questionnaires, learning walks, feedback from PE Consultant, analysis of registers, and data analysis. This will be shared with the PE nominated governor and governors at the resources committee termly.
