PRICE INCREASE IN SCHOOL MEALS FROM SEPTEMBER 2017

With the effect from 1st September 2017 the cost of school meals will increase in line with East Riding recommendations from £2.20 per meal to £2.30 per meal (£11.50 per week) for primary children.

We regret we have had to do this but believe that the meals still represent excellent value for money.
