Implementing the “Sports Premium” in our School.

The Government has given every Primary School funding to develop Physical education and competitive sport.

In the academic year **2017-2018** Brockholes CE (C) J & I School will receive **£17800**.

In our school we are using this funding by working with the Pennine Sports Partnership to:

- Increase the amount of competitive sport in which our children participate.
- Make links to other community sports providers.
- Develop additional clubs and activities for children, outside the curriculum.
- Encourage our children to improve their leadership skills through sport.
- Give extra support in PE to our most talented children and include those with special needs in sport.

The subscription for being part of Pennine Sports partnership for 2017-2018 is **£1205**.

In addition to the above, this academic year we have funded 2 sports coaches to work with children every day at lunchtime, organise activities and increase the amount of children involved in competitive sport. This will cost **£7275**.

Since finding out about the increase to the amount of Sports Premium money that is being allocated to schools this year, not all spending has been allocated. The Governing Body Health and Wellbeing working party are going to be working alongside our staff and children to identify the most appropriate use of the extra funding that will be sustainable for the future provision.

The long term aim is higher quality lessons and improved learning for all children.

In 2013 – 2015 we brought in PE and sports specialist teachers and coaches to work alongside class teachers in lessons for 1 day each week.

Our children gained new skills and experiences and teachers learnt new techniques and knowledge to aid them in teaching sport and PE.

In 2013-2014 we worked with specialist teachers in the following areas: athletics, gymnastics, dance, tennis, multi sports

In 2014-2015 we worked with specialist teachers in the following areas: fencing, multi skills, dance, multi sports

Since September 2015 class teachers are now putting their new knowledge and techniques into practise and teaching their own sport and PE.
