Look at these New Displays in School

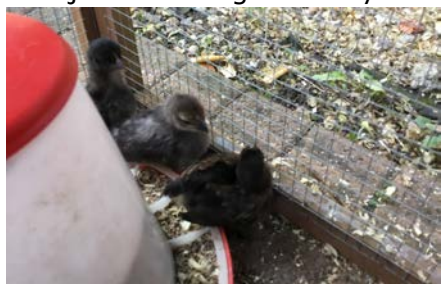
Our Online Safety Warriors have been busy with this display. Notice the QR codes which direct children to videos and extra information.

After School Cooking Club

We have had some fantastic feedback from the parents and children who took part in our first cooking club. Due to its popularity we will be running another club after half term as well as one after Christmas. Families will be chosen from the previous applications. The names will be pulled out of a hat. If you are selected then we will contact you before the club begins.

Could your child be entitled to Free School Meals?

You may be aware that the government has changed the way it funds schools.

One of the changes that has been made is to provide extra funds based on the amount of pupils who have an official entitlement to receive free school meals.

I would like to know if you would help the school gain extra budget allocation by notifying me if your child could be eligible for free school meals and completing an application form to apply for eligibility, (even if they do not take them.)

To be eligible, you (as parents/guardians) need to receive:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seekers' Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of less than £16,190. (If you also claim Working Tax Credit you are not eligible)

Please be aware that by notifying school in this way, it is not an application to take meals. If you would like to apply for your child to receive free school meals please ask for a form at the office.
