Next Week in English

Year 3

After half-term, Year 3 will be starting our new English unit with a look at some poetry and then learning our new story - the tunnel. There will be plenty of opportunities for drama and performance.

Year 4

Year 4 will be learning to write free verse poetry. They will focus on using figurative language including personification and metaphors for emotion.

Year 5

Next term, we will be looking at adding suspense in to our writing. We will also be learning a tale of an alien abduction.

Year 6

In the first week back after half term, we will be learning about poetry. We will be identifying the rhythm of the poem as well as identifying the other features the poet has used. We will also be thinking about how the poet has created mood and atmosphere. By the end of the week, we will be creating our own poems in the style of the poem we have been looking at.

Next Week in Maths

Year 3

After half term, Year 3 will be completing their current work on mental addition before moving onto mental subtraction. This will include subtracting a three-digit number and ones, a three digit number and tens, and a three digit number and hundreds.

Year 4

Year 4 will be learning to use the formal methods for addition and subtraction.

Year 5

After half term, Year 5 will be revising place value and formal methods for addition and subtraction.

Year 6

Next half term in maths, the children will be learning the formal written methods for all four operations and solving problems that involve reasoning.
