

Bronze School Games Award

We are proud to share that we have been awarded the **Bronze School Games Mark**. School Games Mark is a Government led awards scheme that aims to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community.

The accreditation assesses how many pupils engage in sporting activity, the number of competitions we have been involved with, how many pupils are involved in sports leadership (e.g. Sports Council, Playground leaders) and links with local clubs. The School Games Mark only takes account of games activities so the number of children participating in active clubs such as archery, street dance, gymnastics etc. cannot be counted for this award.

At Copley we strive for excellence in all areas so we are now aiming for the Silver School Games Mark. This year we have joined a new local sports network and this is providing more opportunities to get involved in competitions and our new football club has proved very popular. Many thanks to Miss Hull, Miss Keep and Miss Newton, who support our children at sporting competitions.


Secondary School Admission September 2018
