P.E. and Sport Premium – DFE Guidance

Buying in of high-quality coaching.	<p>Children from Reception to Year 6 received high-quality lessons from qualified coaches. Series of lessons are planned in conjunction with teachers in a range of sports and activities, including basketball, football and athletics.</p> <p>After-school activities are ongoing with clubs including Multi-skills, Football and Dance. Participation rate currently stands at 37%.</p> <p>We also employed a highly qualified coach to run our football team and run weekly training sessions. In addition to this, a specialist teacher delivered weekly lessons, focusing upon specific areas.</p>
Subsidise entry fees and transportation to sporting competitions and festivals.	We have participated in all cluster festivals and competitions this year and will continue to monitor the participation rates in order to identify any opportunities to further develop Physical Education in school. A number of school teams have been successful in their current season and cup competitions, particularly our KS2 Tennis teams.
Purchase of additional P.E. resources.	P.E. and outdoor play equipment has been replaced as necessary over the course of the year.
Professional Development of Staff for the delivery of Physical Education.	A specialist PE teacher has delivered lessons alongside staff from Reception – Y2, focusing upon areas of dance, gymnastics and fundamental basic moves. This PE specialist has worked with the class teachers throughout the school to guide the progression and skills during sessions and a series of lessons.
