Pupil Premium Statement

The Pupil Premium is funding provided to schools which is additional to main school funding. It is allocated according to the number of pupils on-roll who are eligible for free school meals (FSM), a smaller amount allocated according to the number of children of service families, and an allocation for each pupil who has been 'Looked After' (in care) for 6 months or more. In 2012, funding was extended to include pupils who have been eligible for free school meals within the past 6 years.

It is for schools to decide how the Pupil Premium is spent, since they are best placed to assess what additional provision should be made for the individual pupils within their responsibility. However, schools are to be held accountable for how they have used the additional funding to support pupils from low-income families. From September 2012, this information must be published on the school website. Please see below for information regarding how the pupil's premium was spent in the last financial year, the impact of this funding, and the plans for future spending

We ensure that the money is spent wisely and that all our children at Kents Hill Junior School benefit from the additional funding.

- Employing Pupil Premium co-ordinator role delivering small groups interventions for Reading, Writing and Maths. 1; 1 Tuition, individualised class support- 5 afternoons a week to support children on an individual needs basis.
- We provide after school booster sessions for children as and when they need it and some resources have been provided with pupil premium funding to aid this.
- We offer support in subsidising some trips. Our school values life experiences and ensure all children have access to these.
- We provide Reading interventions- Rapid Reading programme, buddy reading, we love reading week, weekly storytelling, dedicated time daily, and comprehension focus weekly. (on-going focus)
- We offer a Nurture Room Provision supporting emotional, social, behavioural, sensory, physical and auditory needs.
