

You will be given **3 weekly activities that must be done**. In addition, you have a further 4 activities you could choose from below. We are hoping you will put in a lot of effort for each piece and you will enjoy sharing all your hard work with the rest of the class.

WEEKLY	Reading (At least three times a week).	Spellings (Practise your spellings for your test). Complete the weekly home learning tasks set by Miss Moseley.
TERMLY	As part of our science work this term we are looking at light. Your task is to measure the length of an object's shadow outside at three different times of the day. Draw three simple labelled diagrams to show your experiment. Does the measured length of the shadow change? Write a short explanation of why you think this might be. Top tip: choose a sunny day to do this experiment!	Dragons play a key role in Chinese culture and especially at Chinese New Year. Your task is to produce your own collage, drawing or 3D model of a Chinese dragon. There are some great ideas online! Then write a short explanation about why the Chinese believe dragons are so important.

You could present your work in any way you like, for example as a poster, as a fact file in your home learning book, as a Powerpoint, the possibilities are endless!
