



## Curriculum Guide

Here is a short summary of the curriculum your child will be following this half term.

You can help by;

- Sharing a book with your child each day
- Helping your child with their learn by heart target or multiplication tables
- Speaking to your child about their work and day at school
- Making sure they have the right equipment for school
- Checking their homework diary each week

Reading	This half term children will be exploring The Iron Man. We will make predictions throughout this story about what will happen next and have discussions about what these predictions mean for our characters. We will also think about how lonely the Iron Man would feel and what we could do to make him feel better.	
Writing	In writing, we will use our story to create an effective writing style. We will be creating a character description of our Iron Man using pronouns, a range of prepositions and adjectives in our writing.	
Mathematics	<p>This half term we will explore addition, subtraction and finding the difference. We will look at how we can use jottings and written methods to add and subtract numbers.</p> <p>We will investigate if different questions are takeaway questions or find the difference questions.
