We are holding a **Book Fair** after school in the hall from Friday 10th November to Wednesday 15th November. A leaflet is coming home with your child.

Thank you to those parents who called Allerdale last Thursday morning about the **dog fouling problem** in the village. As a result of this the 'Street Scene Officer' called to see me in school. She has recommended that I advise you to download the app 'My Allerdale' from which you can easily report incidents of dog fouling, anonymously if you want to. As well as dog fouling you can also report fly tipping, abandoned cars, overflowing litter bins etc. Any case of dog fouling will be cleaned up within 24 hours of being reported. You can click on a map on the app and it pin points where the incident has taken place and what's really useful to them is if you actually observe an incident happening. You can report the person, what they and their dog looked like and the time in case there is a pattern to when the fouling is happening and the officer can visit and hopefully 'catch them in the act' so to speak. They do impose the £80 fine if they can and take anyone not paying to court.

Parents need to apply now for 30 hours free childcare for next term

If you're offering 30 hours free childcare next term, your parents need to start applying now to get their codes. They can find out more and apply at www.childcarechoices.gov.uk

Parents should **apply by 30 November** to get their code in good time for next term.

If they're already using 30 hours, they'll need to confirm that their details are up to date every 3 months. They can do this through their childcare account.
