As a part of our annual Wellbeing Week we are holding the Tim Peake Challenge run by the Triathlon Trust. This will be held on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> November, and will last all day. The day will begin with an assembly, with a video from astronaut Tim Peake to introduce the challenge to the children.

Each year group (from 1-6) will have a 40 minute slot, cycling on stationary bikes in the hall and running around the field and playground. Every child will be active for approximately 24 minutes. The goal for the children is to run and cycle 400km as a school. This is the distance to the International Space Station!
