Choir

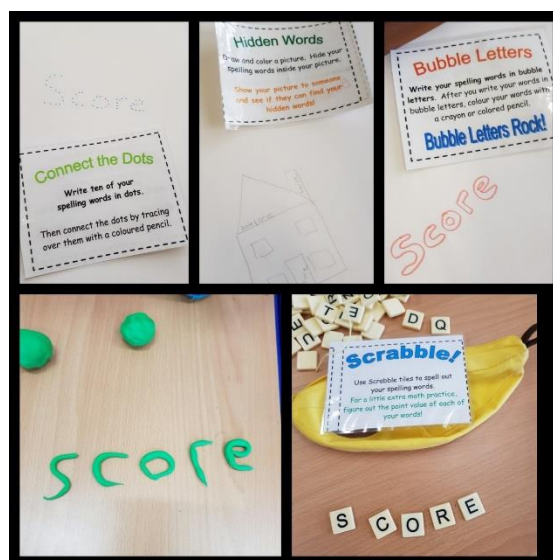
