CHRISTMAS CONCERTS

- Thursday 7th December – both concerts will begin at **6.00pm**

FOUNDATION CONCERT... “The Pop-up Nativity”

- Thursday 14th December
- Friday 15th December – both concerts will begin at **9.45am** and parents are welcome to join us for a drink and mince pie from 9am.

We hold the Foundation concert at a separate time so that our very youngest children perform to a smaller audience. Parents are welcome to come to the hall as soon as they have dropped their child off and we will serve drinks and mince pies before the concerts begin.

INFANT CONCERT [children in Y1 and Y2] ... “Star of Wonder”

- Friday 15th December – both infant concerts will begin at **2pm**

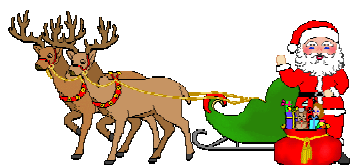
TICKET SALES

Tickets will be on sale for both concerts from **Monday 27th November**. These will be available each morning and at the end of the day from the **SCHOOL OFFICE**.

The cost of the tickets will be £2.00 for the junior concert and £1.00 for each of the Foundation and infant concerts.

As in previous years we will, initially, be allocating 3 tickets per family for the junior concert and 3 tickets per family for the foundation and the infant concerts. We feel that this is the fairest way to ensure that everyone gets an equal chance to purchase tickets. We will offer tickets for sale in this way from Monday 27th November until [and including] Thursday 30th November, but **FROM FRIDAY 1st December** any remaining tickets will be available on a **FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS**.

Please note that no tickets are reserved, even though we allocate three tickets per family, they must be purchased in school during this week.

CHRISTMAS SERVICES IN OUR CHURCHES



CHRISTINGLE SERVICE – Aston Parish Church

Sunday 10th December at 4.00pm

There will be our very special Christingle Service on Sunday 10th December. This is a beautiful service, held in All Saints Church, especially for the children, which begins just as it becomes dusk! Everyone will receive a lighted Christingle during the service which can then be taken home and the goodies decorating the orange can be eaten!

It is traditional to donate the collection from a Christingle service to the Children's Society. A collection for this charity will be taken during these services.

There will be an **evening service at Ulley Church** on Sunday 10th December at 6.30pm and the Aston All Saints Choir will be singing during this service.

There will be a **Family Carol Service with Nativity followed by a party for the children at Ulley Church** on 19th December at 4.30pm

On Sunday 17th December at 6.30pm will be “**CAROLS BY CANDLELIGHT**” in All Saints Church.

This is a beautiful service, by candlelight as the title suggests and an opportunity to get everyone into the true spirit of Christmas. There will be special readings, beautiful music from the choir and an opportunity to join in singing traditional carols. This service will also celebrate the retirement of Paul Hudson, Director of Music, who is retiring at Christmas. Paul has been in this role for forty years and many children from the church school have joined the church choir over the years and in

recent years Paul has also worked with our choir in school as they joined the confirmation services and sang with the church choir.

THE CRIB SERVICE

Christmas Eve at 4.00pm - in All Saints Church

A service especially for the children, as the final preparations for Christmas are made and the children help place all the nativity figures in the crib.

The midnight service, in All Saints Church, on Christmas Eve begins at 11.30pm and everyone is welcome to join in the first communion of Christmas.

I do hope that you will be able to join us at our Christmas services; you will be made very welcome.

Other news and information

Aston All Saints Church Christmas Fair

This will take place in All Saints Church on Saturday 25th November starting at 1pm. Look out for posters advertising the Fair!
