What we will be learning about this term...

Creative Curriculum

This term will be very interesting in years 3 and 4. The children are investigating the question ‘Who were the really Rotten Romans?’

The children thoroughly enjoyed their recent Roman Hook day, in particular the Teacher Slave Auction. Over the coming weeks they will learn about the Roman Invasion on Britain and its lasting effect.

Computing

This half term all children in year 3 and 4 will be learning how to use coding to create their own apps and games.

PSHE

Our new theme for this term is ‘Safety.’ Throughout this theme children will learn how to stay safe both inside and outside of school.

Science

In Science Year 3 pupils will be learning about lights and shadows. Year 4 pupils will be learning about sound.
