National Anti-Bullying Week 13th Nov - 17th

'Be kind - Make a Difference'

This week we have been talking to the children about Anti-Bullying week and how we should all work together to ensure everyone feels valued, respected and safe in school. In assembly and at my tea-party with the children on Friday I will conclude the week by going through these points;

- To make sure that all the children and adults in school mean the same thing when we discuss the term 'bullying'.
- To make sure that all the children are confident to tell an adult if they know there is any form of bullying going on.
- To make sure all children know exactly what to do if they feel they are being bullied, and feel confident that they know something will be done

Likewise if parents have any concerns at all related to this please do make an appointment to see your child's teacher. All parents can access our school anti-bullying policy on our website www.evertonheath.org.uk.

Ask your child

To help parents find out what is going on in school each week we will give a list of questions for parents to ask their children linked to lessons and activities from the week before. This week;

- Ask your **Reception Class Child** to tell you the names of all the shapes that they know.
- Ask your **Year 1** child to describe the 4 seasons.
- Ask your **Year 2** child why we have day and night.
- Ask your **Year 3** child what a *Copper Child* worked as in the Bronze Age
- Ask your **Year 4** child to describe a Hill Fort.
- Ask your **Year 5** child what they learnt at Sandy Upper School during their Science day.
