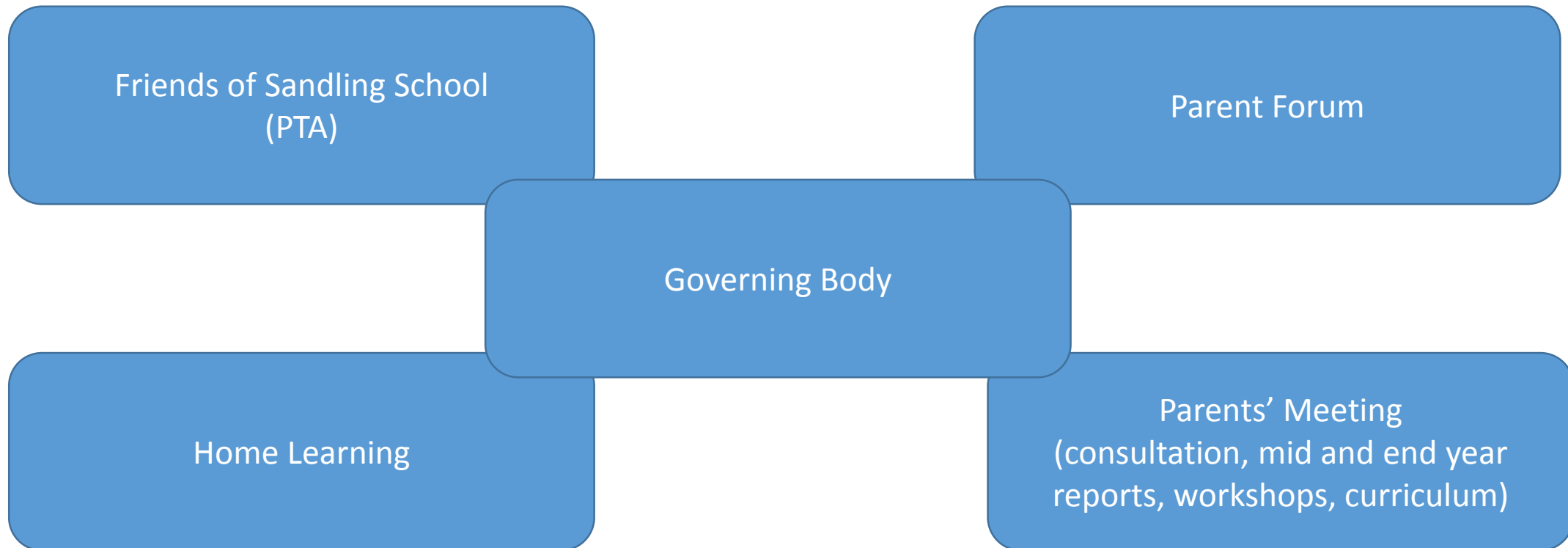

Starting school in September 2018

You can apply for September 2018 places from 6 November 2017 until 15 January 2018.

Children should start primary or junior school if born:

- Between 1 September 2013 and 31 August 2014.

- The schools admissions criteria is in line with the Local Authority as follows;

- 1. Children In Care

- 2. Siblings

- 3. Health/Medical Needs

- 4. Distance

- Over last 3 years children who have lived up to under 0.8 mile as the crow flies from the centre of our site have been offered a place, last year it was just over 0.6. Admissions can tell you your address distance if you e-mail them.

- The LA look at first preference, allocate these places based on the admission criteria i.e. distance, siblings and then if they can't give a first preference move onto second, third etc.

- Closing date; 15th January 2018
- National Offer day; 16th April
- Welcome letters from the school; 18th April
- Places rejected/accepted and waiting lists; 14th May
- Appeals until 16th May
- Vacant places reallocated 15th June

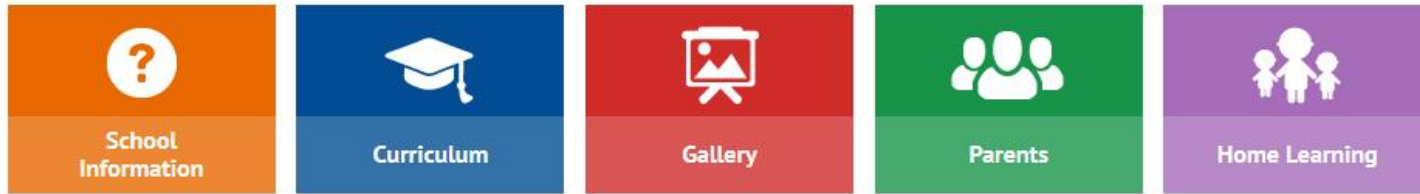
