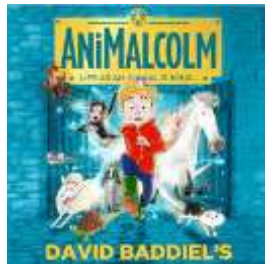
Overall school attendance was 95.9%

Family Support Worker Position

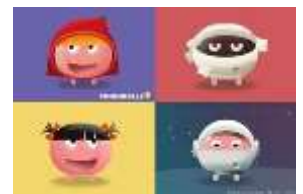
